- 1 Children of less than 3 years should be kept away unless continuously supervised.

They should not plug in regulate. perform maintenance or clean the appliance.
- 3 DO NOT insert or allow objects to touch the heating element and never place anything on the heater safety guard (e.g. towels), as this may damage the heater and could cause an electrical shock or fire. Never use your heater to dry washing. If the heating element has stopped glowing it may still be live, please check that the heat setting indicates the heater is off. Always disconnect your appliance from the mains before any cleaning.
- 4 DO NOT use the heater in areas where petrol paint, or other flammable substances are stored. In order to avoid overheating, do not cover the heater.
- 5 Always unplug the heater when not in use. To disconnect from the power supply, grip the plug and pull from the power socket. Never pull by the cord. Cable length: 1.9m or as per outer box
- 6 DO NOT direct the heater towards curtains, furniture or other flammable objects.
- 7 Extreme care should be taken when the heater is used near children and pets.
- 8 Do not use the heater with a programmer, timer or any other device that switches the heater on automatically, since a fire risk exists if the heater is covered or positioned incorrectly. Heater should not be positioned directly under a socket outlet.
- 10 This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with
- 11 If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- 13 WARNING: This heater is not equipped with a device to control the room temperature. Do not use this heater in small rooms when they are occupied by persons not capable of leaving the room on their own, unless constant supervision is provided.

Cleaning and maintenance

Before cleaning or changing heating tubes, turn the heater off, unplug from the power supply and wait for the unit to cool down

- 1. To clean the heater use a soft cloth to wine off any dust 2. If the heater is very dirty, use a damp cloth and wipe dry. Do not use any cleaning detergents, sprays
- or other chemicals, as they will damage the unit.
- 3. When the heater is not in use for a long period, clean and cover it.







### Remote control operation

You need to turn on the Power Switch before you can operate from the Remote Controller. Operational range of remote is approx 4m (open air) as it is infared only. There is a plastic slice at the end of the Remote Controller for insulating the battery. Pull it out when in use and insert it back when not to last the using time of the battery.






